## Timeline

October 18th	Information Blurbs to be submitted by students/teachers. The information blurb is a paragraph about the costume that will be read out during their walk, it can cover anything from what inspired the piece, the process, materials used etc. Here is a <a href="#">LINK to a blank template</a> <a href="#">LINK to folder</a>
October 18th	Schools (WSLs) to confirm the total number of students (designers/models) taking part in the show. <a href="#">Link to form</a>
October 19th	<b>POSTPONED</b> - Photoshoot that was scheduled for this date has been moved to dress rehearsal night (Nov 6th).
November 6th	4:00-6:00 pm - Full Dress Technical Rehearsal (North Street School) for all sections. This is compulsory for all entries. Please make sure you bring anything that you need for your full costume, including make up. Both the designer and model need to be at this rehearsal. Bring something to eat and drink, please be on time.
November 7th	Wearable Arts Performance (North Street School) 5:00 pm - doors open for designers and models. Make sure you bring your whole costume and anything you need for make up and hair, plus a repair kit for your costume should something break or fall off. All models from all sections must be ready by 6pm. Bring something to eat and drink, please be on time. 5:30 pm - Doors open to public 6:30 pm - Show starts at 6.30 sharp.
